1998 Clos de l'Oratoire. (à partir de 90% de merlot). La robe rubis saturé offre des reflets pourpres. Des arômes très primaires de cassis, de mûre, de caramel et de réglisse évoquent l'encre. Onctueux, dense et soyeux, ce vin offre des saveurs de mûre et de réglisse qui explosent littéralement en bouche. Les tannins substantiels sont cependant mûrs et fins. La finale est extrêmement longue et subtile. C'est le millésime le plus prometteur jusqu'ici pour ce vin. Certains des premiers dégustateurs ont préféré ce Clos de l'Oratoire au Canon La Gaffelière, qui évolue toujours plus lentement. **89-92.**

1997 Clos de l'Oratoire. Belle robe, rubis profond. Arômes complexes et sauvages de framboise noire, de viande fumée et de cuir. Ce vin, doux, onctueux et expressif en bouche, révèle des nuances animales vraiment plus fortes que le Canon La Gaffelière ou le Mondotte, deux autres Saint-Emilion de Stephan von Neipperg. C'est un vin très suave et frais pour le millésime. La finale est longue et présente des tannins bien mûrs. La moitié de ce vin a fermenté dans des cuves de bois, ce qui, selon Stephan von Neipperg, a permis une meilleure harmonisation des tannins. **89-90.**

1996 Clos de l'Oratoire. Robe rubis très profond. Le nez libère des arômes soutenus de framboise noire, de caramel, de gibier et de fourrure animale. En bouche, ce vin est moins riche que le 97 ou le 98. Ainsi, son gras juvénile n'est pas suffisant pour masquer l'acidité et le boisé. Il offre une jolie douceur ainsi qu'une belle longueur (cependant pas exceptionnelle). En 96, ce vin a été élaboré pour la dernière fois dans des cuves de fermentation en inox. **87.**

Readers should note that proprietor Stephan von Neipperg (also the proprietor of Canon-La-Gaffelière and La Mondotte) has pushed this wine's quality into St.-Emilion's top echelon. As most consumers know, Bordeaux can be frightfully expensive, but Clos de l'Oratoire remains fairly-priced for its quality.

1997: One of the stars of the vintage, this opaque ruby/purple-colored wine offers copious quantities of jammy black cherries and lavish, smoky new oak. Fat, fleshy, and rich, with sweet tannin, medium to full body, and gorgeous concentration and fruit, it can be drunk now, but

promises to be even better with 2-3 more years of bottle age. It will last for 12+ years.

1998: This spectacular effort has added considerable weight and aromatic dimensions since it was tasted last year. A saturated black/purple color is accompanied by an enormously rich constitution and spectacular aromatics. A flamboyant nose of espresso beans, blackberries, cherries, licorice, Asian spices, and new oak is followed by a thick, full-bodied, rich wine with significant power, sweet tannin, and a blockbuster finish. A terrific wine! Anticipated maturity: 2005-2020.

Comte de Neipperg's recent acquisition of Clos de l'Oratoire has completely resurrected this property, which is now one of the finest in St.-Emilion. Readers should take note, as prices have not yet caught up with the splendid quality of the wines.

1998: An opaque blue/purple color is accompanied by a sensational bouquet of melted fudge, plums, Asian spices, blackberries, and prunes. Smoky, barbecue-like spices also emerge with airing. Full-bodied, super-extracted, rich, pure, and mouth-saturating, this large-

scaled effort can be consumed with pleasure, but it will age for two decades. Anticipated maturity: 2002-2020.

1999: Another outstanding effort, this forward, plump, dark purple-colored 1999 possesses terrific concentration of black fruits intermixed with smoke, earth, truffles, and new wood. The wine is dense, full-bodied, low in acidity, extremely ripe, and hedonistic. The tannin is largely concealed by the wine's glycerin and fat. Anticipated maturity: 2002-2015.
